I. Background.

This agreement addresses the planning and conduct of Section 7 consultations under the Endangered Species Act (ESA) by the National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) related to hazardous fuels treatment activities by the Department of the Interior (DOI) authorized and funded under Title IV of the FY2001 Interior appropriations bill. The ESA regulations implementing Section 7 (50 CFR 402) direct all Federal agencies to use their existing authorities to conserve threatened and endangered species and, in consultation with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and NMFS, to ensure that their actions do not jeopardize the continued existence of listed species or destroy or adversely modify designated critical habitat. This agreement is established to support interagency collaborative planning, streamline procedures, and expedite consultation services provided by the NMFS, and ensure that fuels management actions by DOI wildland fire agencies (Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), National Park Service (NPS), and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS)) are implemented in a timely and effective fashion in compliance with Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act. Fuels management actions, also referred to as hazardous fuels reduction, include, but are not limited to, mechanical, chemical, biological, and fire treatments that result in elimination of excess vegetation.

Streamlined consultation procedures will be used for the fuels management program in accordance with the July 1999 agreement between NMFS, BLM, FWS, and U.S. Forest Service. Under this agreement, Federal land management agencies and NMFS work together closely during project development to plan and locate projects in a manner that reduces or avoids adverse effects on threatened or endangered species and their critical habitat. After early collaboration has occurred, NMFS has agreed to conduct formal consultations in 90 days instead of the 135 days authorized by 50 CFR 402. For informal consultations, NMFS has agreed to complete

consultations in 30 days where 50 CFR 402 does not establish a fixed time line. NMFS and the DOI wildland fire management agencies agree that these streamlined and expedited procedures would apply to fuels management projects.

II. Objective.

To obtain from NMFS for the wildland fire management agencies of DOI, streamlined and expedited consultation, coordination, planning and review services for fire management actions in accordance with priorities established in the Annual Operating Plan described in section IV.E. herein. These services will be provided on a reimbursable basis with funds appropriated under Title IV of the FY2001 Interior and Related Agencies Appropriations Act.

III. Authorities.

This Agreement is made and entered into between NMFS, a federal agency within the Department of Commerce, and the BLM on behalf of the DOI land management agencies. Title IV of Public Law 106-291 (Interior and Related Agencies Appropriations Act) provides funding for BLM to purchase such services from NMFS on a reimbursable basis.

NMFS and BLM enter this Agreement pursuant to the authorities provided in the Economy Act (31 U.S.C. 1535, as revised).

As set forth in the attached determinations and findings pursuant to 48 CFR 17.503, DOI warrants that sufficient funding amounts are available, that this agreement is in the best interest of the United States Government, and that the services requested cannot be provided by contract as conveniently or cheaply by a commercial enterprise. NMFS has statutory responsibility for ESA consultations on listed salmon and steelhead, has expertise and authority for salmonids that is not available in DOI, and has determined that it is able to provide the services under this Agreement.

IV. Statement of Work.

- A. NMFS agrees to secure additional staff necessary to provide streamlined, expedited Section 7 consultation, coordination, planning and review services in support of the efforts of the DOI land management agencies to carry out fuels management projects authorized and funded by Title IV of the FY2001 Interior and Related Agencies Appropriations Act. Timing and location of Section 7 consultation services and any other coordination, planning and review will be based upon land management agency project priorities and the availability of NMFS staff under this reimbursable agreement. NMFS will not exceed the \$2M funding limit for the first project year unless NMFS and BLM agree to amend this agreement and BLM provides additional funding for continued services.
- B. All aspects of section 7(a)(2) consultation between NMFS and the DOI land management

agencies will be governed by the interagency consultation regulations at 50 CFR Part 402 and the ESA Consultation Handbook.

- C. BLM agrees to reimburse NMFS for all costs associated with the expedited consultation, coordination, planning and review needs caused by the increased number of fuels management projects. These costs include the hiring, training and placement of additional NMFS staff, and the labor, benefits, travel, communication, supplies, equipment, and facility costs for NMFS staff involved with planning and conduct of consultations on fire management activities.
- D. NMFS will use the streamlined consultation process with a goal to complete informal Section 7(a)(2) consultations within thirty (30) days and formal consultations within ninety (90) days.
- E. An annual operating plan (AOP) will be jointly developed and approved by the agencies' designated representatives within 30 days of this Agreement and annually at the start of each project year. The AOP will contain project priorities, an estimate of the number of proposed fuels treatment projects, project locations, NMFS estimated personnel requirements, equipment needs, availability of wildland fire management agency space and fiscal provisions. The AOP will be designed as a flexible document and adjustments to the plan may be made by mutual agreement by the affected parties. The AOP will become a part of this signed agreement. FY

- F. NMFS will submit quarterly reports that include a synopsis and cost estimate of consultation, coordination, planning and review services furnished to each of the DOI wildland fire management agencies for fuels management projects.

V. Payments.

- A. BLM shall reimburse NMFS up to \$2.0 million annually. This agreement may be amended as necessary to the extent that BLM seeks to purchase continued services beyond the \$2 million dollars provided annually. Additional funds may be made available by BLM if the actual costs for staffing and support to conduct project planning and consultations exceeds the funding provided.
- B. Indirect administrative charges will be limited to 20% as specified in the FY 2001 Interior and Related Agencies Appropriation Act (P.L. 106-291).
- C. Transfer of funds to NMFS will be through the On-Line Payment and Collection (OPAC) system on a quarterly basis.
- D. An obligation document will be required annually.
- E. The agencies' obligation for performance of this agreement is contingent upon availability of appropriated funds from which payments can be made. Funding levels shall be

shall be established annually, consistent with workload under an updated AOP, through the duration of the agreement.

VI. Termination.

The terms of this interagency agreement shall become effective upon signature by all parties and shall remain in effect for five (5) years. The agreement must be renegotiated every five (5) years. Any party, in writing, may terminate this agreement at any time before the date of expiration, provided that 60 days notice is provided, if either: 1) no additional appropriations are made available to execute the purposes of the agreement, or 2) an event beyond the control of the agencies makes the agreement unenforceable.

VII. Administration.


- A. The terms of this agreement may be modified by written modification hereto, by mutual consent of all parties and signed by authorized officials.
- B. No Federal or Tribal official shall be admitted to any share or part of this agreement or any benefit that may arise therefrom.
- C. The parties agree to waive all claims against each other for compensation for any loss, damage, personal injury, or death occurring in consequence of the performance of this agreement.
- D. Nothing in this agreement shall be understood to impair the right of the United States or Tribes to recover costs damages, or penalties from third parties under applicable Federal or Tribal law.

VIII. Resolution of Disagreements

Nothing herein is intended to conflict with current DOC or DOI directives. If the terms of this agreement are inconsistent with existing directives of either of the agencies entering into this agreement, then those portions of this agreement which are determined to be inconsistent shall be invalid, but the remaining terms and conditions not affected by the inconsistency shall remain in full force and effect. At the first opportunity for review of the agreement, all necessary changes will be accomplished either by an amendment to this agreement or by entering into a new agreement, whichever is deemed expedient to the interest of both parties.


Should disagreement arise on the interpretation of the provisions of this agreement, or amendments and/or revisions thereto, that cannot be resolved at the operating level, the area(s) of disagreement shall be stated in writing by each party and presented to the other party for consideration. If agreement on interpretation is not reached within thirty days, the parties shall forward the written presentation of the disagreement to respective higher officials for appropriate resolution.

This modification to the Agreement between the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management (BLM); on behalf of the Interior's Wildland Fire Management Agencies, and the U.S. Department of Commerce, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration-National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) reduces the amount of funds obligated for conducting services related to compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act associated with hazardous fuels treatment activities authorized and funded under Interior appropriations. The original projection of required services was over estimated and this modification will provide the corrective adjustment. This modification also corrects the cited authorities. The effective date of this modification will commence on the date of the last signature, and it will remain in effect through March 28, 2006, or as otherwise agreed and modified. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.




