NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Increased fire activity occurred in the Northwest Area and continued in Southern California. Minimal initial attack activity was reported elsewhere. Demobilization continues in the Great Basin.

NORTHWEST AREA LARGE FIRES:

DREWS, Fremont NF. Strong winds hampered containment efforts and are predicted to continue gusty today. No other information reported.

NO NAME, Washington State. This fire is north of Sheldon, WA. on the Olympic Peninsula. No other information reported.
