

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 25, 2000 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION:

One new large fire and a flood disaster were reported in Arizona. Containment objectives were met on the large fire in California. Initial attack activity was moderate in the Southern Area and light elsewhere. The National Interagency Coordination Center mobilized a shower unit to the flood in Arizona. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Minnesota.

EASTERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

CARLOS EDGE, Minnesota State Forestry. A State Type II Incident Management Team (Stegmeir) is assigned. This fire is burning in grass, peat and mixed hardwood fuels one mile west of Wyoming, MN. Mopup continues primarily in 45 acres of peat.

LA PAZ, Arizona State Land Department. Heavy thunderstorms on 10/22 caused flash flooding in Wenden and Aguila, AZ. Approximately 400 to 500 structures have been damaged and 500 residents have been evacuated.

Protection

OUTLOOK:

*** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH IS POSTED IN MISSISSIPPI FOR LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY AND LOW FUEL MOISTURES ***

An area of low pressure will stall off the west coast bringing scattered rain and snow showers to northern California. Snow levels will be 7000 feet. Southern California will have partly cloudy skies. High temperatures will be in the 40's to 60's in the mountains and coastal areas, and in the 70's and 80's elsewhere. Minimum afternoon relative humidity will be 20 to 40 percent. Winds will be south to southwest at 10 to 20 mph except higher along the coast and near precipitation.

Low pressure over the central United States will lift into Minnesota bringing scattered showers and a few thunderstorms to the area. High temperatures will be in the 60's. Winds will be southeast at 5 to 15 mph. Minimum relative humidity will range from 60 to 80 percent.
