Area Command Team (Zimmerman) is assigned to assist the Northern Rockies with analyzing assessments for long duration fires and emerging incidents.

Jocko Lakes, Flathead Agency, BIA. IMT 1 (Wilcock). Twenty-six miles northeast of Missoula, MT. Timber with dead and down lodgepole pine. Active backing with single and group tree torching. Community of Seeley Lake and numerous structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Chippy Creek, Northwestern Land Office, Montana DNR. Transfer of command from IMT 2 (Raley) to IMT 1 (Bennett) today. Forty-two miles southwest of Kalispell, MT. Timber, dead and down lodgepole and logging slash. Active crowning. Residences threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Skyland, Flathead NF. IMT 1 (Pendleton). Thirty-two miles east of Kalispell, MT. Timber and grass. Torching and occasional short duration crown runs. Structures threatened.

Columbine 1, Yellowstone NP. IMT 2 (Grant). Fifty-three miles west of Cody, WY. Timber. Sustained crown runs. Residences threatened. East entrance to the park has been closed.

Sawmill Complex (three fires), Lolo NF. Transfer of command from IMT 2 (Heintz) to IMT 2 (Turman) tomorrow. Twenty-two miles southeast of Missoula, MT. Timber. Very active fire behavior with group tree torching, crown runs and intermediate-range spotting. Structures threatened.

Brush Creek, Flathead NF. IMT 2 (Koehler). Twenty-five miles west of Whitefish, MT. Timber. Isolated torching and crown runs. Structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Rattlesnake, Nez Perce NF. Transfer of command from IMT 2 (Secret) to IMT 2 (Kusicko) today. Twenty-five miles south of Elk City, ID. Timber and grass. Surface fire with single and group tree torching. Community of Comstock and outlying structures threatened.

Rombo Mountain, Bitterroot NF. FUMT (Svalberg). Eighteen miles south of Darby, MT. Bug-killed timber. Single and group tree torching with short crown runs and spotting. Structures threatened.

Wicked Creek, Gallatin NF. IMT 1 (Stanich). Twenty-seven miles south of Livingston, MT. Timber. Torching, crowning and spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Poe Cabin, Craig Mountain Area Office, Idaho Department of Lands. IMT 2 (Sciacca). Twenty-three miles southwest of Grangeville, ID. Timber and grass. Torching, upslope runs and short range spotting. Structures threatened.

Fool Creek, Lewis and Clark NF. Thirty miles northwest of Choteau, MT. Timber and snags. Torching, short range spotting and crown runs. Structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Bridge, Clearwater NF. Forty-five miles southwest of Missoula, MT. Timber and brush. Backing fire with single and group tree torching and short-range spotting.

Ahorn, Lewis and Clark NF. IMT 1 (Whitney). Thirty miles west of Augusta, MT. Timber. Smoldering and creeping with isolated single and group tree torching. Structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Meriwether, Helena NF. IMT 1 (Oltrogge). Thirty-seven miles northwest of Helena, MT. Timber, brush and grass. Interior and perimeter runs with single and group torching. Structures threatened.

Maxwell, Miles City Field Office, BLM. Fifty miles southeast of Miles City, MT. Timber and grass. Torching.

Moon Creek Settlement, Eastern Land Office, Montana DNR. Timber and grass. Extreme wind-driven fire activity. Structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Wolf Creek, Miles City Field Office, BLM. Fifty miles southeast of Miles City, MT. Timber, brush and grass. Runs, torching and spotting. Structures threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Conger Creek, Lolo NF. Twenty miles north of Ovando, MT. Timber. Active surface fire.

Rat Creek, Beaverhead/Deerlodge NF. IMT 2 (Kaage). Twenty five miles west of Wisdom, MT. Timber. Sustained crown fire with long-range spotting.

Pattengail Creek, Beaverhead/Deerlodge NF. Ten miles northeast of Wisdom, MT. Timber with dead and down fuels. Active crown runs, backing fire and spotting.

Boundary Junction, Clearwater NF. Fifteen miles southeast of Pierce, ID. Timber. Extreme fire behavior with torching and spotting.

Chimney Complex, Craig Mountain Area Office, Idaho Department of Lands. Nineteen miles south of Lewiston, ID. Timber and grass. Creeping and smoldering.

Garceau, Flathead Agency, BIA. Fifty-five miles south of Whitefish, MT. Timber and grass. No further information received.

Lost Creek, Crow Agency, BIA. Six miles southeast of Pryor, MT. Timber and grass. Torching and flare-ups in the interior. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Bitterroot Fire Use Complex (13 fires), Beaverhead/Deerlodge NF. Includes previously reported WFU incidents Harrington Ridge, El Capitan West, Patsy Anne, Elkhorn Ridge and Snake Ridge. Fifteen miles west of Darby, MT. Timber. Active single and group tree torching. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.

Beaverdam, Yellowstone NP. Fifty-six miles west of Cody, WY. Timber. Torching. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.

Promontory Complex, Yellowstone NP. Sixty-three miles west of Cody, WY. Timber. Active fire with spotting and backing fire. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.

Area Command Team (Loach) is assigned to manage large fires for the Boise and Payette National Forests.

East Zone Complex (three fires), Payette NF. NIMO (Ferguson). Thirty miles northeast of McCall, ID. Timber, brush and grass. Surface fire with short crown runs, torching and spotting. Communities of Secesh and Warren, historic sites and bridges threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Cascade Complex (four fires), Boise NF. IMT 1 (Broyles). Three miles northeast of Cascade, ID. Timber. Extreme fire behavior with crown fire runs, torching, and long-range spotting. Community of Warm Lake and power lines threatened. Evacuations in effect and Warm Lake Highway closed.

Cow Creek, Twin Falls District, BLM. Thirteen miles west of Fairfield, ID. Brush and grass. Running, torching and spotting. Ranches threatened.

Cleveland, Idaho Falls District, BLM. Includes previously reported Cleveland Hills fire. Twelve miles northeast of Preston, ID. Brush and slash. Extreme fire behavior with running and torching. Community of Thatcher and structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Hardscrabble, Bridger-Teton NF. FUMT (Reinarz). Twenty-six miles northwest of Dubois, WY. Bug-killed timber. Wind-driven fire activity with torching and long-range spotting. Highway closures in effect.

Landmark Complex (two fires), Boise NF. IMT 2 (Suwyn). Thirty-four miles southeast of McCall, ID. Timber. Active fire with runs and torching. Historic district of Stibnite threatened.

Shower Bath, Salmon-Challis NF. IMT 2 (Saleen). Eighteen miles northwest of Challis, ID. Timber with heavy dead and down fuels. Active fire with running, torching and spotting. Structures threatened.

Farmington Canyon, Wasatch-Cache NF. One mile north Farmington, UT. Grass. Running, crowning, torching and spotting.

Middle Fork Complex (three fires), Boise NF. IMT 2 (Lund). IMT also managing the Trapper Ridge WFU. Fifteen miles northeast of Garden Valley, ID. Timber and brush. Single tree torching, backing fire and smoldering.

Middle, Bridger-Teton NF. Nine miles east of Alpine, WY. Timber. Torching, crowning, and spotting. Structures threatened.

Mitchell, Idaho Falls District, BLM. IMT 2 (Whalen). Ten miles north of Holbrook, ID. Brush and grass. Running with long-range spotting. Structures threatened.

Trapper Ridge, Boise NF. Twenty-eight miles northeast of Idaho City, ID. Timber. Torching, short crown runs, creeping and smoldering.

Krassel Complex (seven fires), Payette NF. FUMT (Ourada/Soper). Forty-four miles northeast of Yellow Pine, ID. Timber, grass and heavy dead and down fuels. Active fire behavior with group tree torching and short crown runs.

Granite Creek, Bridger-Teton NF. Fifteen miles southeast of Jackson, WY. Timber with heavy dead and down fuels. Active fire behavior.
