Evans Road, North Carolina Division of Forest Resources. Previously reported as Evans. IMT 2 (Hildreth). Seven miles south of Creswell, NC. Pocosin, chaparral, and southern rough. Extreme fire activity. Residences threatened and evacuations in effect.

Hughes Ranch, Texas Forest Service. IMT2 (Hanneman). Started on private land twenty-two miles northwest of Marfa, TX. Juniper, mesquite, oak and grass. Very active fire behavior. Residences threatened.

Taco, Florida DOF. Fifteen miles south of Kenansville, FL. Southern rough. No further information received.

Nova Road, Florida DOF. Ten miles east of St. Cloud, FL. Southern rough. No further information received.

No Entry, Kisatchie NF. One mile south of Williana, LA. Southern rough. Backing fire. Patrol status.
