\*\*\* SAFETY COMES FIRST ON EVERY FIRE, EVERY TIME \*\*\*

Current Situation: Fire activity remained low throughout the U.S. Five Type I crews are being mobilized to Ontario, Canada today by NIFC jet. The other NIFC 737 will move four crews internally for Canada. A Type II Incident Management Team was requested through CIFFC to take over the suppression efforts on the Ontario side of the Sag Corridor fire.

OUTLOOK: \*\*\*\*\* A FIRE WEATHER WATCH FOR DRY LIGHTNING IS POSTED FOR PORTIONS OF NORTHERN NEVADA. \*\*\*\*\* An upper ridge of high pressure will continue over the central and southern portions of the western United States. The air mass is cooler and more humid over the Pacific Northwest, northern Idaho, and northwest Montana. The ridge of monsoon moisture covering the desert Southwest has moved north to affect an area from the Southern Rockies west to the Sierra Nevada of California, and north through the Great Basin to southern Oregon. High temperatures will be in the 70's along the Pacific coast and the Northern Rockies. Temperatures will be in the 90's to 115 degrees in the desert Southwest. The remainder of the West will be in the 80's and 90's. Northern Minnesota will be sunny with highs in the 70's and afternoon northwest winds at 10-20 MPH. No significant fire activity is expected. Additional resource mobilization to Canada is anticipated.
