

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 MONDAY OCTOBER 16, 1995 - 0530 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: Good progress was made in meeting containment objectives for large fires in South Zone with minor initial attack activity occurring in the region.

SOUTH ZONE CALIFORNIA LARGE FIRES:

BLUFF, Riverside Ranger Unit, California State. A State Type I Team (Sunderland) is assigned. The fire is actively burning out several drainages with some hot spots along the northern control lines. Estimated containment and the demobilization of surplus resources are planned for today.

WARNER, San Diego Ranger Unit, California State. A State Type I Team (Benson) is assigned. The fire is 100% contained and will be turned over to local units today.

OUTLOOK: A Pacific cold front will sweep into the Northwest and the Northern Rockies today. This will bring breezy and cloudy weather into this area with a chance of light showers, mainly over higher terrain. An onshore flow will develop along the entire Pacific coast. Sunny and dry weather will continue for the desert Southwest, Great Basin, and Central and Southern Rockies. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's in the northwestern tier of the U.S. California and the desert Southwest will have highs in the 80's and 90's with readings near 100 in some areas. Fire activity should be moderate in California with other areas having minimal activity.
