 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: Fire activity moderated in most areas this past week with cooler temperatures and some precipitation. The Southern Area continued to experience numerous initial attack fires throughout the area. No large fire activity was reported nationally.

OUTLOOK: A cold front will move southeast across Arkansas, Mississippi, Alabama and Missouri today bringing a wetting rain. Sunday will be drier but an upper level low pressure area will move across those areas from west to east through Monday bringing more rain. Another system will approach from the west Wednesday with more showers developing. Highs will be in the 30's in the northern portion of this area to the 60's in the southern portion. Southern California will have an onshore flow of marine air persisting through the middle of next week. Pacific storm systems will bring a chance of showers at times through next week. Highs will range from the 50's at higher elevations to the 70's in the warmer desert areas. Fire activity is expected to moderate in several areas with rain forecast for next week.
