

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 SUNDAY, OCTOBER 4, 1998 - 0900 MDT
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Minimal initial attack activity was reported. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for miscellaneous overhead. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Texas, Oregon and Montana.

SOUTHERN AREA INCIDENTS:

CHURCH ROCK, George Washington and Jefferson NF. This fire is burning in heavy brush and Gypsy Moth killed overstory. Steep, rocky terrain and snags are hampering control efforts.

HURRICANE GEORGES: Birch's Type I Incident Management Team is operating a Receiving and Distribution Center at Roosevelt Roads Naval Base in Puerto Rico. The Team continues to support FEMA efforts on the island. The Team has now processed 1.1 million pounds of ice.

Wand's Type I Incident Management Team is operating a Receiving and Distribution Center in Montgomery, AL. The center will be staffed 12 hours effective today.

Bennett's Type I Incident Management Team has been operating a Receiving and Distribution Center at Camp Beauregard in Pineville, LA. The Team is demobilizing today.

OUTLOOK:

Idaho, northern Utah, Montana and Wyoming will be cool with a chance of showers as a strong upper level trough moves across the area. Snow levels will range from 5,000 feet in Idaho to 7,000 feet in northern Utah. Winds will be southwest to northwest at 15-30 MPH. High temperatures in the West will range from the 40's in the northern Rockies, 60's to 70's in California valleys and lower Great Basin, and 80's to lower 90's in the deserts.

West Texas and the Oklahoma panhandle will be mostly sunny and breezy. Winds will be southwest at 15-25 MPH. High temperatures will be in the

mid 80's to mid 90's.
