

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT  
 FRIDAY, MARCH 10, 2000 - 1000 MST  
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION:

Large fire activity continued in the Southern and Eastern Areas. Containment was reached on several large fires in the Southern Area. The National Interagency Coordination Center processed orders for crews, helicopters, a lead plane, an air tanker, radio equipment, and miscellaneous overhead. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Missouri, Kentucky, Tennessee, and Virginia.

SOUTHERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

KISATCHIE WILDERNESS, Kisatchie National Forest. A Type I Incident Management Team (Melton) is assigned. This fire is 10 miles south of Natchitoches, LA in a wilderness area. Burnout operations began last night and will continue today. Higher humidity and light winds are assisting suppression efforts.

HARRIS, National Forests in Alabama. The fire is 7 miles west of Addison, Alabama. Some large stands of timber in a Forest Service plantation were damaged. Several structures are threatened.

HICKORY CREEK TRAIL, Chattahoochee-Oconee National Forest. This fire is burning in a wilderness area east of Chatsworth, Georgia. Steep, rocky terrain and access to the fire are causing challenges to containment.

EASTERN AREA LARGE FIRES:

LAKE OF THE OZARKS COMPLEX, Missouri State Forestry. This complex of 140 fires is located in the Lake of the Ozarks area of Missouri. Four

residences and 30 outbuildings were damaged or destroyed. Winds up to 50 MPH hampered containment efforts. A FEMA suppression grant has been requested for this incident.

SULPHUR LICK, Ohio State Forestry. This human-caused fire is burning in hardwoods, five miles west of Portsmouth, OH. Several mobile homes are threatened.

PEARTREE, Mark Twain National Forest. This complex consists of 20 fires along a forest road 20 miles east of Branson, MO. Steep terrain and gusty winds have slowed suppression efforts. Containment was expected last night.

CORN CREEK, Mark Twain National Forest. This fire is 20 miles southwest of Rolla, MO. The fire is burning in hardwood leaf litter, slash, cedar, pine and tall grass. Suppression efforts are directed at protection of hunting cabins on private lands. Containment was expected last night.

OUTLOOK:

Louisiana will be mostly cloudy with showers and thunderstorms. Winds will be south at 5 to 15 MPH. High temperatures will be in the 70's.

Kentucky and Tennessee will be partly cloudy in the west and mostly sunny in the eastern portions. There will be a chance of showers and thunderstorms in the southern and western areas in the late afternoon. Winds will be light and variable. High temperatures will range from the lower 50's in the north to about 70 in the southeast.

Florida and Georgia will be partly cloudy after areas of morning fog. There will be a slight chance of showers in Georgia and the eastern Florida panhandle. Winds will be southeast to southwest at 6 to 12 MPH. High temperatures will range from the upper 60's in northern Georgia to the lower 80's in southern Florida.

Missouri will be mostly cloudy with a chance of snow in the northwest. Rain is likely in the southeast, while the eastern part of the state will have afternoon showers. Winds will be northeast at 5 to 15 MPH. Temperatures will be in the upper 30's in the northwest to the mid 50's in the southeast. Humidity will be lowest in the southeast portion of the

state.
