Big Turnaround Complex, Okefenokee NWR. IMT 1 (Ruggiero). Ten miles southeast of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Backing and flanking fire with high flame lengths. Numerous structures, historic sites and recreation facilities remain threatened.

Sweat Farm Road, Georgia Forestry Commission. North Carolina IMT 2 (Hildreth). IMT also managing the Bugaboo Scrub 2 fire. Started on private land ten miles west of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Isolated torching and moderate rates of spread. Numerous residences remain threatened.

BICY Complex (four fires), Big Cypress National Preserve. IMT 1 (Whitney). Fifty-one miles west of Ft. Lauderdale, FL. Southern rough. Limited fire activity due to precipitation. Evacuation orders lifted.

Florida Bugaboo, National Forests in Florida. Unified Command between NIMO (Ferguson) and Florida IMT 2 (Beauchamp). Thirty miles northeast of Lake City, FL. Southern rough. Ground fire with smoldering and isolated reburning. Numerous residences remain threatened.

Okeechobee Complex (three fires), Florida DOF. Eight miles southwest of Okeechobee, FL. Tall grass. Minimal fire activity. Precipitation occurred. Residences remain threatened.

Big Starr Complex (thirteen fires), Cherokee NF. IMT 2 (Wilder). Seven miles southeast of Englewood, TN. Hardwood litter. Backing fire. Residences threatened.

Bugaboo Scrub 2, Georgia Forestry Commission. Previously reported. Started on private land four miles east of Fargo, GA. Southern rough and timber. Isolated torching and moderate rates of spread within control lines.

Deland Complex (seven fires), Florida DOF. Six miles west of Ormond Beach. Southern rough. Reburning in timber. Residences remain threatened.

Dairy Road, Florida DOF. Seven miles northwest of Keystone Heights, FL. Southern rough. Increased interior burning. Numerous structures threatened.

Middle of Nowhere, Florida DOF. Previously reported. Fifteen miles northeast of Ft. Myers, FL. Southern rough. Interior burning. Fire received precipitation.

Kerry Tully, Florida DOF. Eight miles east of Dade City, FL. Southern rough. Creeping and smoldering. Light precipitation over the fire.

Buck Shank, Great Smoky Mountains NP. Ten miles south of Maryville, TN. Hardwood litter. Minimal fire activity.

Paterson, Florida DOF. Eighteen miles east of Lehigh Acres, FL. Southern rough. Approximately .5 inch of rainfall on the fire area, no fire activity.

Harvey Town, Georgia Forestry Commission. Two miles southwest of Pembroke, GA. Spotting.
