Big Turnaround Complex, Okefenokee NWR. Transfer of command from IMT 1 (Ruggiero) to FUMT (Perkins) on 6/13. Ten miles southeast of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures, historic sites and recreation facilities remain threatened.

Sweat Farm Road, Georgia Forestry Commission. Georgia IMT 2 (Floyd). Ten miles west of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Creeping and smoldering.

Okeechobee Complex (three fires), Florida DOF. Eight miles southwest of Okeechobee, FL. Grass. Smoldering.

Deland Complex (seven fires), Florida DOF. Six miles west of Ormond Beach. Southern rough. Burning in piles.

Middle of Nowhere, Florida DOF. Fifteen miles northeast of Ft. Myers, FL. Southern rough. No new information. Last report unless new information is received.
