Childress Ranch, Texas Forest Service. IMT 2 (Hannemann). IMT is also managing the Juno fire. Started on private land twenty miles southwest of Ozona, TX. Chaparral, cedar and grass. Isolated smoldering.

Browntown, Georgia Forestry Commission. Three miles northeast of Atkinson, GA. Southern rough. Interior flare-ups, creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened. Road closures in effect.

Tracy, National Forests in Florida. Three miles northeast of Paisley, FL. Pine and brush. Minimal fire behavior. Precipitation occurred over the fire area.

Brevard Complex (6 fires), Florida DOF. Brevard County, FL. Southern rough. Interior burning and smoldering.

Mud Swamp New River, National Forests in Florida. Five miles northeast of Sumatra, FL. Southern rough. Isolated torching with short-range spotting.

Juno, Texas Forest Service. Ten miles south of Juno, TX. Cedar, juniper and grass. Isolated smoldering.
