

TRAINING FOR AGENCY MANAGERS

The following chart outlines required and recommended training for various levels of agency administrators, fire program managers and other agency managers of the five federal wildland fire management agencies. As interest from the states has been expressed as well, state recommendations are included.

These recommendations were approved as policy for the five federal wildland fire management agencies by the Federal Fire & Aviation Leadership Council on February 12, 1998.

This chart accomplishes Action Item #64 of the Implementation Action Plan for the 1995 Federal Fire Policy Review.
