Predictive Services Discussion:

Dry and breezy conditions will develop in the eastern Sierra and east of the Transverse and Peninsular Ranges in southern California into southern Nevada and northwest Arizona, including minimum relative humidity of 8-20% and wind gusts of 40-50 mph. A cold front will push south and east through the Great Lakes and into the Northeast by tonight. Isolated to scattered showers and thunderstorms will accompany the frontal passage in parts of the northern Plains and northern Great Lakes. Scattered to widespread thunderstorms are expected over much of Florida, Georgia, and Alabama, with the heaviest rain likely from southern Georgia into north Florida. Severe thunderstorms are likely from northwest Texas into the Oklahoma and Texas Panhandles and northeast New Mexico, while isolated to scattered thunderstorms are expected in the central Intermountain West and southern and central Rockies onto the High Plains.
