





FY 2014 Accomplishments

- Improved video feature by adding embedded video converter with improved video upload feature

Quick InciWeb Tips

- **Contacts:** If an email is attached to a contact - the contacts name appears in **orange** as a hyperlink on the public site under **Incident Contact**. When clicked on your email browser opens.
- Use the **Data Filter** on the InciWeb homepage to search for incidents within a year old.
- If you want to copy/paste a summary in the **Summary** tab on the Administrative Site use the **Paste from Word** feature on the tool bar next the hyperlink button.
- Make sure you include the incident type in the incident name so that Twitter followers can easily find and follow your incident.
- The **Summary** tab on the Administrative Site translates as the **Incident Overview** section on the public InciWeb site.
- Make sure your NAP password is not expired. Passwords expire every 60 days.

What you need to know about InciWeb in 2015

- All incidents that are not updated within 30 days in InciWeb are automatically deactivated. *(A superuser can reactivate the incident if necessary).*
- All units listed in the NWCG Unit Identifiers book are included as units in InciWeb.
- Improved relationships between InciWeb and GeoMac will allow all incidents with perimeter maps to show up on InciWeb for that particular incident.
