Subject: ROMAN Shutdown

Last week the National Weather Service Western Region Headquarters (NWS), the University of Utah (UofU) and Predictive Services determined that the NWS can no longer support maintenance and operation of ROMAN. On 27 April 2016, the primary web interface for ROMAN (<http://raws.wrh.noaa.gov/roman/>) will be turned off as well as supporting hardware. Other supportive infrastructure, such as the RAWS port from WFMI, will be transferred to the UofU to continue to provide real-time RAWS data through the MesoWest website.
