Subject: National Mobilization Requirements for Type 3 General Staff Positions – Change of Implementation Date to October 2019.

Please reference the attached NWCG memorandum which communicates a revised implementation date of October 2019 (upon release of the 2019 PMS 310-1) for Type 3 general staff positions and clarifies Position Task Book (PTB) administration requirements. This memorandum replaces NWCG Executive Board memorandum 16-016 *Transition Plan for Upcoming Changes to National Mobilization Requirements for Type 3 General Staff Positions*. Please forward this information to the Coordination Group Advisory Council.

Agencies having jurisdiction for wildfires, agency policies, protecting agencies, and IMT3 governing boards all have a role in determining appropriate incident management team mobilizations in their assigned areas. Agencies are strongly encouraged to adopt these qualification standards for responders performing in these positions, regardless of incident jurisdiction, protecting agency, level of mobilization, or Type 3 Incident Management Team composition/governance.

We encourage all geographic areas to take advantage of training opportunities for type three team members and to utilize the guidance provided in the attached NWCG memorandum.

The type 3 incident management team configuration standards for national mobilization will be published in the 2019 national mobilization guide.

NMAC appreciates the work of CGAC and looks forward to the progress to be made in addressing these issues associated with type 3 incident management teams.
