Current Situation: Winds in southern California have caused increased fire activity. A Type II Helicopter has been ordered through NICC for the fire on Channel Islands NP.

Southern California Large Fires:

CHINESE HARBOR, Channel Islands NP. This fire is a result of unanticipated high winds on a prescribed burn. The fire burned rapidly through grass, brush and a Gibson Pine stand. Current threats are to a U.S. Naval facility and historical buildings.
