

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 TUESDAY NOVEMBER 22, 1994 - 0530 MST
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: Precipitation aided suppression efforts in Georgia, while fire activity continued in Tennessee and Kentucky. Resource mobilization continued through NICC. Mary Jo Brown, a silviculturist from the Brasstown District of the Chattahoochee/Ocnee NF, was fatally injured Sunday while performing firefighting duties on the Cedar Mountain Complex. The entire firefighting community from all agencies extends their sympathy to family, friends and co-workers of Mary Jo Brown.

Southern Area Fires:

CEDAR MOUNTAIN COMPLEX, Chattahoochee/Ocnee NF - A Type I Incident Management Team (O'Bannon) is assigned. The complex consists of the CEDAR MOUNTAIN, RED CLAY GAP, TOWNSEND and TESNATEE fires. Precipitation reduced fire activity on the fires.

CHEROKEE NORTH COMPLEX, Cherokee NF - A Type II Incident Management Team (Coats) is assigned. The complex consists of PAINT MOUNTAIN, BLUFFTON, MORRELL and CHUCKY fires. Three of the four fires in this complex are arson caused.
