

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 23, 1994 - 0530 MST
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: Fire activity continued in the Southern Area. Resource mobilization through NICC has moderated.

Southern Area Fires:

CEDAR MOUNTAIN COMPLEX, Chattahoochee/Oconee NF - A Type I Incident Management Team (O'Bannon) is assigned. The complex consists of the CEDAR MOUNTAIN, RED CLAY GAP, TOWNSEND and TESNATEE fires. The complex has been contained. The Incident Management Team is scheduled for demob today.

CHEROKEE NORTH COMPLEX, Cherokee NF - A Type II Incident Management Team (Coats) is assigned. The complex consists of the PAINT MOUNTAIN, BLUFFTON, MORRELL and CHUCKY fires. The Bluffton and Paint Mountain fires continued to burn active yesterday. Current threats are to structures near the Bluffton fire. Burnout operations are planned for today.
