

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
THURSDAY OCTOBER 6, 1994 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

Current Situation: Containment efforts on large fires continue to be aided by cool temperatures, high humidities, and scattered precipitation. These same influences are also keeping initial attack activity low. Demobilization through NICC remains steady.

Eastern Great Basin Area Large Fires:

THUNDERBOLT, Boise NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (McAtee) is assigned. The fire is being turned over to the forest today.

CORRAL CREEK/BLACKWELL COMPLEX, Payette NF. A Type I Incident Management Team (Lee) is assigned. Fire activity continues to be low.

CHICKEN COMPLEX, Payette NF. Minimal fire activity consists of creeping and occasional torching.
