Current Situation: Fire activity continued to be low for the entire nation.

Eastern Great Basin Area Large Fires:

CORRAL CREEK/BLACKWELL and CHICKEN COMPLEX, Payette NF. The three incidents were turned over to the District and are now being managed as one Complex. The fires will be monitored by aerial recon, weather permitting.

Outlook: *** A RED FLAG WARNING is posted for moderate winds, low humidities, and high Burning Index in southern California. *** Low pressure over the central Rockies will dominate the western states weather with cool, moist conditions. High pressure will push in along the west coast and start to warm and dry the region as it nudges the low pressure system. The high pressure will create moderate winds and lower humidities in southern California. The potential for increased activity exists in southern California due to red flag conditions.
