Current Situation: The Southern Area and California experienced increased fire activity. Minimal fire activity continued throughout the remainder of the U.S.

Southern Area Large Fires:

RED BIRD MOBILIZATION, Daniel Boone NF. The Redbird Ranger District of the Daniel Boone NF has experienced increased arson incidents for the last four days. The current acreage reflects a total of 9 fires. Prevention, suppression and law enforcement efforts continue.

Outlook: A storm westerly flow aloft is bringing rain and windy conditions to the Pacific Northwest. Oregon, Washington, western Montana and the Idaho panhandle could see substantial amounts of moisture over the next few days. Northern Idaho, eastern Washington and Montana will have gusty as a surface low pressure system deepens over Alberta. The remainder of the West will continue to be mild with partly cloudy skies, except southern Idaho, Montana and Wyoming which will have cloudy skies. Fire activity is expected to remain low in the West. Increased activity is possible in the Southern Area.
