OUTLOOK: ***** A FIRE WEATHER WATCH FOR DRY LIGHTNING IS POSTED FOR CENTRAL AND EAST-CENTRAL NEVADA FOR TODAY. ***** An upper ridge of high pressure will continue over the central and southern portions of the western United States. The air mass is cooler and more humid over the Pacific Northwest, northern Idaho, and northwest Montana. Monsoon moisture will spread north affecting the central and southern Rocky Mountains, the Great Basin, the desert southwest, and the Sierra Nevadas of California. High temperatures will range from the 80's to low 90's in the northern states of the West, and the 90's to over 100 degrees in the desert Southwest. Northern Minnesota will be sunny with light winds and highs in the 80's. Fire activity is expected to remain low.
