Current Situation: Fire activity increased in the Southern, Eastern, Eastern Great Basin and Northwest Areas yesterday. An airtanker was mobilized to the Southern Area yesterday. Canada has requested nine Type I Crews and an Infrared aircraft for the Province of Ontario.

Northwest Area Large Fires:

SUGAR, Deschutes NF. The fire is located 15 miles south of Bend, OR. The current threat is to the Mokst Butte Research Natural Area.

OUTLOOK: An upper ridge of high pressure will cover the entire West today. Monsoon moisture with increased relative humidities and wet thundershowers will cover the California deserts, most of Nevada, eastern Idaho, Wyoming, Colorado, Utah, Arizona and New Mexico. High temperatures will be in the 70's along the Pacific and 90's to 115 degrees in the Southwest deserts and central valley of California. The remainder of the West will be in the 80's and 90's. Northern Minnesota will be sunny with highs in the 70's and northwest winds at 10-20 MPH. Moderate fire activity and continued support to Canada is expected.
