Current Situation: Moderate fire activity continued throughout the U.S. NIFC continues to support Canada, with nine Type I Crews, chainsaws and Mark III pumps being mobilized to Timmons, Ontario today. 131,256 acres burned in Canada yesterday.

OUTLOOK: The ridge of high pressure aloft remains over the western U.S. A trough of low pressure will slightly weaken the high pressure over the Pacific Northwest. Monsoon moisture with high relative humidities and wet thundershowers will continue over the Great Basin and Rocky Mountains. High temperatures will be in the 70's along the Pacific and 90's to 115 degrees in the Southwest deserts and central valley of California. The remainder of the West will be in the 80's and 90's. Northern Minnesota will be sunny and cooler with highs in the 70's and northeast to east winds at 5-15 MPH. Moderate fire activity is expected to continue.
