OUTLOOK: High pressure aloft over the western US will continue to weaken. This will cause the jet stream to sag to the south through the weekend. A Pacific cold front will bring rain, snow, and cooler temperatures to northern California. Southwest winds will increase ahead of the front. Snow levels

should be between 6000-7000 feet. The front will bring cooler temperatures to southern California with a slight chance of showers. An onshore flow should develop with increasing southwest winds through the weekend.
