OUTLOOK: A major winter storm will develop over the Great Lakes and the Mississippi Valley today and will reach the Atlantic Seaboard by Saturday morning. A cold front will trail southward from this storm into northern Florida Saturday. Widespread and locally heavy rain will extend from the Gulf Coast up the Atlantic Seaboard. The Great Lakes, Ohio Valley and Appalachians will have a mixture of snow and ice. A large Canadian high pressure system will follow the storm Sunday and Monday with gusty winds and very cold temperatures. Temperatures will begin to moderate Tuesday and Wednesday with a few snow or rain showers developing in the Mississippi and Ohio Valleys. The Atlantic coast from Florida northward will remain dry Monday through Thursday. California will remain dry Friday and Saturday. A major Pacific storm will bring rain to northern California Sunday and over the entire state Monday and Tuesday. Locally heavy rain and mountain snow is possible with this storm in the northern and central sections of the state. Showers and cooler temperatures will likely continue Wednesday and Thursday, especially in the north. Fire activity should moderate in most areas with forecasted weather.
