NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: The Southern Area continued to experience initial attack activity. New Mexico State reported increased fire activity.

Outlook - A slow moving frontal system will move across the Southern Area today through Sunday with widespread rain and cool temperatures. The front will drop southward into central Florida on Monday, while high pressure builds to the west. High pressure will remain over the Southern Area Tuesday through Thursday with dry, mild weather. Initial attack activity is expected to continue.

NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: The Southern Area continued to experience initial attack activity. Arkansas had two large fires prompting the early activation of an air tanker. Eastern Area, particularly Missouri state, experienced a marked increase in initial attack and large fire activity.

Outlook - A frontal system will move across the southeast Friday and Saturday bringing scattered showers and cool temperatures. Another frontal system will move slowly across the central and southern states Monday through Thursday with scattered showers. Highs will be 50's to 60's, except 45 to 55 Friday in Missouri.
