Current Situation: The Northwest, North Zone, and Great Basin experienced moderate initial attack activity from recent lightning. Demobilization is continuing from the Southwest, with four type 1 crews scheduled for release.

Outlook: High pressure aloft lies over the Rocky Mountains with an upper low along the central California coast. Hot weather will prevail over the entire western U.S. except along the immediate Pacific coast. Scattered wet thunderstorms are likely for all areas except the immediate Pacific coast, southern California and southern Nevada. Most of the West will have highs in the 80's and 90's, with temperatures of over 100 degrees forecast for the Southwestern deserts. Moderate initial attack is expected in the Northwest, North Zone, and the Great Basin. The potential for large fires remains low.
