Current Situation: Initial attack activity continued to increase in several areas of the West due to recent lightning activity. An additional nineteen smokejumpers were mobilized to the Northwest Area yesterday.

Eastern Great Basin Large Fires:

THATCHER MOUNTAIN, Utah State. The fire size increased due to heavy fine fuel loadings and high winds from thunderstorm activity in the area. Mop-up is in progress and no problems are anticipated at this time.

Western Great Basin Large Fires:

FRENCHIE FLAT, Nevada State. This wind driven fire spread rapidly upslope in heavy grass, threatening structures on two different ranches before changing direction. Firefighters are making good use of natural barriers to contain the fire.

Outlook: A light southwest flow aloft will continue over the western U.S. Hot weather will remain over the interior, with cooler conditions along the immediate Pacific coast. Scattered wet thunderstorms are likely again today for the Rocky Mountains, northern Great Basin and interior Pacific Northwest. Most of the interior West will have high temperatures in the 80's and 90's, with temperatures of over 100 degrees in the Southwest deserts. Initial attack activity is expected to continue throughout the western U.S.
