NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

*** SAFETY COMES FIRST ON EVERY FIRE, EVERY TIME ***

Current Situation: Large fire and initial attack activity increased dramatically in South Zone yesterday. The remainder of the West continues to experience normal levels of initial attack activity. Large fire activity continued in Canada with 301,009 additional acres burned yesterday.

South Zone California Large Fires:

DAWSON, Riverside Ranger Unit, California State. Strong winds and high temperatures are contributing to control problems. Homes in the Spanish Hills area are threatened.

TECATE 10, San Bernardino Ranger Unit, California State. This is one of a continuing series of fires set along the California-Mexico border.

PILGRIM, San Bernardino Ranger Unit, California State. Multiple fingers in steep terrain (up to 100% slopes) are contributing to control problems. Structures are threatened.
