Current Situation: Initial attack activity continued across the western U.S. Numerous units in Arizona, southern California, Nevada, Utah and the Rocky Mountain Area are reporting very high and extreme fire indices.

Southwest Area Large Fires:

SHOVEL, Coronado NF. The fire caused a temporary power outage to Mt. Lemmon. Crews are holding the fireline with support from helicopter bucket drops.

Outlook: Strong high pressure continues over the desert Southwest. Several weak disturbances will move across southern Canada bringing more clouds and rain to western Washington and northwest Oregon. There should be enough moisture to cause isolated thunderstorms over Washington, northern Idaho and northern Montana. Very hot and dry conditions will continue in Arizona, Nevada and California. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's in western Washington and western Oregon, and from 110 to 120 in the desert southwest. The remainder of the West will have highs in the 80's and 90's. Moderate initial attack activity is expected to continue, while large fire potential is increasing throughout the West.
