

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
FRIDAY NOVEMBER 17, 1995 - 1000 MST
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: Fire activity remained minimal throughout the Geographic Areas.

OUTLOOK: A high pressure system will bring dry weather and light winds to California today. A weak upper level trough will move into northern California this afternoon and Saturday providing a chance of showers. High pressure will strengthen over the area from Sunday through mid-week causing dry and warm weather. High temperatures will range from the 50's and 60's in the north and mountains to near 90 in the southern deserts. Minor fire activity is possible in southern California until precipitation occurs.
