WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 25, 1995 - 0530 MDT
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: Fire activity yesterday was limited to initial attack in the reporting Geographic Areas.

OUTLOOK: A weak pressure pattern across southern Oregon, California and Arizona will continue to bring dry weather and generally light winds today. High temperatures will range from the upper 50's to mid 60's in southern Oregon and northern Arizona. Temperatures will be in the 70's through much of California, with a rise into the 80's from the central California valleys to the Arizona desert. Moderate fire activity is expected in California and the Arizona desert.
