OUTLOOK: High pressure continues to build along the West Coast. A weak area of low pressure off the California coast is spreading high level clouds over much of the western United States. High temperatures will range from the 60's along the coast to the mid 90's in the desert Southwest. Minimum relative humidities over the Southwest will range between 10 and 20 percent. The potential for moderate fire activity continues in parts of California and the Southwest.

This will be the last daily Incident Management Situation Report unless significant activity occurs. A weekly report will be produced every Friday at 1000 MST.
