NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

Current Situation: Moderate fire activity continued throughout the U.S. The Northeastern states have reported light rain and higher humidities which has helped moderate fire behavior.

Northwest Area Large Fires:

CHELAN COMPLEX, Wenatchee N.F. A Type I Incident Management Team (Wands) is assigned. The 526 acre Prince Fire on the east side of Lake Chelan is 60% contained. The small fires making up the remainder of the complex are either contained or being managed under confinement strategy.

OVERHOLD, Malhuer N.F. The fire is confined at 300 acres and will be managed under a confinement strategy. There will be no further report unless significant changes occur.
