OUTLOOK: A cold front will push southeast across Florida bringing scattered showers and thunderstorms. High pressure behind this front will bring dry weather through the weekend. A strong and windy storm system with showers and thunderstorms will develop over northwest Texas Monday and move into the Mississippi Valley Tuesday. This activity is expected to spread over much of the southeastern U.S. from mid to late week. Much cooler weather will move in behind the front. High temperatures will range from the 50's and 60's in the northern portion of the of the southeastern states to the 70's along the Gulf coast and Florida. Southern Texas will have highs in the 80's. Mid to late week temperatures will cool about 30 degrees behind the front in north Texas and 10-15 degrees across the Gulf Coast and Florida.
