

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT

 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Fire activity continued in the Southern and Eastern Areas. High to very high fire dangers are being reported on numerous units in the Southern Area. Minor resource mobilization occurred to the Southern Area through NICC. Two airtankers are available at Fort Smith, AR. Good progress continues on large fires in the Southern and Eastern Areas. Flood recovery and damage assessment efforts are continuing in Oregon, Washington, Idaho and Montana.

Southern Area Fire Information:

McFaddin NWR has a new 2,500 acre fire. No other information available.

Texas National Forests has a new 150 acre fire burning in a remote area. No other information available.

River Birch, Texas State. Containment was expected on 2/14. No new information received.
