

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
 MONDAY, FEBRUARY 26, 1996 - 0530 MST
 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Fire activity in the Southern Area moderated yesterday with the presence of higher humidities and lighter winds. Resource mobilization through NICC decreased with mainly supply and miscellaneous overhead requests. High to extreme fire danger remains on numerous units throughout the Area.

Southern Area Fire Information:

ADA COMPLEX, Muskogee Area Office, Ada Agency, BIA. A Type I Incident Management Team (O'Bannon) is assigned. Increased acreage is the result of several fires not previously accounted for. Lower temperatures and higher humidities decreased fire activity yesterday. Homes, livestock and oil facilities remain threatened.

OKLAHOMA STATE FIRES. Since the current fire activity began in Oklahoma, an estimated 400,000 acres have burned. A preliminary damage assessment shows 30 single family dwellings and 15 mobile homes have been destroyed in the state. No new information was reported on the 12,000 to 20,000 acre Stillwater fire. A Type II Incident Management Team (Kearney) is assigned to the State to manage fire activity north of I-40, they will be based out of Muskogee.

TEXAS STATE FIRES. Higher humidities and lighter winds moderated fire activity yesterday. The National Forests of Texas are providing technical assistance to the Department of Defense at Ft. Hood on a 30,000 acre fire. Staging areas are being set up in Waco and Decatur. Resources will be ordered and held in these staging areas under the conditions set in the disaster declaration.
