 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

Current Situation: Large fire activity occurred in southern California. California Department of Forestry activated a CDF airtanker due to activity. Initial attack fire activity occurred in Florida, South Carolina, Alabama and Arizona. The "Blizzard of '96" has caused several National Parks and Forests in the Mid-Atlantic states to activate snow removal crews.

South Zone California Large Fires:

HONEY, San Diego County. The fire started 1/10/96. High winds caused the fire to spread quickly, threatening residences in and around the towns of Jamul and Dulzura. Calm winds yesterday allowed containment last night.

OUTLOOK: High pressure over the Great Basin will weaken early today bringing an onshore flow and cooler temperatures to California and increased winds in Arizona. Temperatures continue to be above normal for the interior sections of southern California and Arizona, with no precipitation forecast through Monday. A Pacific weather system will move into the western U.S. Tuesday bringing some cooling and a slight chance of rain through Thursday. Texas and Louisiana will have a dry northwest flow dominate the weather through next week. High temperatures will be in the 60's and 70's.
