

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT
FRIDAY, MARCH 1, 1996 - 0530 MST
NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Fire activity continued at a moderate pace in the Southern Area yesterday. Fire danger ratings have moderated on most units. Mobilization of resources through NICC remained minimal.

Southern Area Fire Information:

ADA COMPLEX, Muskogee Area Office, Ada Agency, BIA. A Type I Incident Management Team (O'Bannon) is assigned. Initial attack forces continued to work on the Teresa fire yesterday. Local volunteer fire departments continue to handle the majority of new starts. To date, the Complex has responded to 42 fires.

NORTHEAST OKLAHOMA COMPLEX. A Type II Incident Management Team (Kearney) is assigned. Operations personnel scouted the Bug Creek fire late yesterday. State firefighters will take action on this fire today. Aerial detection is now operational north of Interstate 40 and east of Interstate 35 to the state line. Tentative plans are to move the ICP to Bartlesville today, and establish staging areas in Bartlesville and Stillwater.

BLOCK B, Everglades NP. Burn-out operations were nearing completion yesterday afternoon. There is some holdover fire in the hardwood hammocks.

Temperatures will be cooler with highs in the 20's in northern Missouri to the upper 50's in south Texas. Southern Florida will have patchy morning fog and low clouds, with highs in the 70's. Winds will be 5-15 MPH. Fire activity is expected to remain moderate in the Southern Area.
