NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL I

CURRENT SITUATION: Fire activity has continued to diminish in the states of Texas and Oklahoma due to recent rains and the initiation of green up. Demobilization of airtankers, helicopters and overhead is continuing. Activity has moderated in New Mexico.
