CURRENT SITUATION: No significant fire activity was reported yesterday. Minor initial attack activity occurred in the Southwest Area.

Southwest Area Large Fires:

SAWYER, New Mexico State. A Type II Incident Management Team (Blackwell) is assigned. Significant progress was made on fire yesterday. While the fire remains in close proximity to several structures, the threat to these has been reduced. Mop up and demobilization of resources in progress.
