OUTLOOK: An upper level trough moving across the Rocky Mountains will weaken today and decrease the widespread winds by tonight. Southern California, Arizona and New Mexico will be mostly sunny and breezy in the northern portions. Southeast New Mexico will have widely scattered thunderstorms. High temperatures will range from the 70's to mid 80's in the mountains and from 90 to 102 in the deserts. Hot, dry weather conditions are forecast for the weekend in the Southwest and southern California. A stationary front is draped across central and northwest Florida, bringing partly cloudy skies and widely scattered afternoon thunderstorms. High temperatures will be in the 80's to near 90. The potential is increasing for initial attack activity in the Southwest Area.
