OUTLOOK: Santa Ana winds are possible in southern California today and Saturday. Generally dry weather will prevail through the week with windy conditions Tuesday and Wednesday. High temperatures in southern California will be in the 60's and 70's along the coasts and in the deserts with 40's and 50's in the mountains. An upper low in the southwest U.S. will bring rain to Texas and the Mississippi River Valley today and through the weekend. Rain will move into Florida and the Carolinas Monday and Tuesday. Another front with scattered showers is expected to move into Texas and the Mississippi River Valley Wednesday and Thursday. High temperatures will be in the 70's and 80's in Florida with 50's and 60's elsewhere.
