CURRENT SITUATION: Increased fire activity was reported in the Northern Rockies Area. Initial attack activity was minimal throughout the remainder of the United States. Containment objectives were achieved on several large fires across the West.

Northern Rockies Large Fires:

CRAWFORD, Nez Perce NF. This vehicle fire is located 1.5 miles south of Lucille, ID. Firefighters made good progress toward containment objectives. Steep terrain and rolling material have caused concern.

BEAN, Nez Perce NF. The fire is burning in timber, 1.5 miles south of Lucille, ID. Firefighters continue to make progress on line construction.
