 NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL II

CURRENT SITUATION: Fire activity continued in the Eastern Great Basin, and increased in Southern California. Resource mobilization through NICC remained moderate.

Eastern Great Basin Large Fires:

FAYETTE, Bridger-Teton NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (Summerfelt) is assigned. This fire is burning on both Wyoming State and Forest Service lands 5 miles east of Pinedale, WY. A resort, ranch and campgrounds are threatened.

SPILLWAY, Wasatch-Cache NF. This fire is located 10 miles east of Ogden, UT above the Pineview Dam.

WILD, Los Padres NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (McClain) is assigned, Steep inaccessible terrain, hot temperatures and low humidities are hampering control efforts. A few structures (unconfirmed type and amount) have been destroyed.

Northern Rockies Large Fires:

Thirty-four fires are in a confine and contain suppression strategy totaling 54,800 acres.

Northwest Large Fires:

One fire is in a confine or contain suppression strategy totaling 16,005 acres.

OUTLOOK:

A strong upper level ridge from Arizona through the Great Basin will bring unseasonably warm and dry weather with near record high temperatures to much of the West. High temperatures will range from the 70's and 80's in the Rockies, 80's and 90's in the Great Basin and upper 90's in the northern California valleys. The southwest deserts will have temperatures reaching 111.
