CURRENT SITUATION: No significant fire activity was reported yesterday, except the continuing large fires in Southern California.

Southern California Large Fires:

SUR, Los Padres NF. A Type II Incident Management Team (Smith) is assigned. The Type I Incident Management Team (Giachino) was cancelled. The fire is located 3 miles south of Big Sur, CA. Evacuations on the North Coast Highway remain in effect for 25+ single residences, 4 businesses and a state park. Demobilization of surplus resources began yesterday.

One fire is in a confine suppression strategy totaling 350 acres.

Rocky Mountain Large Fires:

One fire is in a confine or contain suppression strategy totaling 765 acres.

Eastern Great Basin Large Fires:

Two fires are in a confine or contain suppression strategy totaling 21,340 acres.

Northern Rockies Large Fires:

Thirty-two fires are in a confine or contain suppression strategy totaling 54,841 acres.

A deep and cold upper level trough centered from the Dakotas to the Four Corners will bring windy conditions from Montana to Arizona and New Mexico with gusty Santa Ana winds in southern California. The central and southern Rockies will have snow showers. The Pacific Northwest coast will have rain. High temperatures will range from the 30's in the Northern Rockies to the 40's and 60's in the Great Basin. The Pacific coast will have highs from the 50's to the 70's. The desert Southwest and southern California will have highs in the 70's to mid 80's.
